The Wood-Carr Community Fund is accepting applications for grants beginning Wednesday, July 5 through Wednesday, August 9, 2017. If you are interested in applying for grant monies on behalf of a non-profit organization located in Wood or Carr Townships, please complete a Wood-Carr Community Fund grant application and return to the address on the application, or, return to the attention of Les Wright at 2104 Trainer Rd., Borden, IN. All applications must be received by end of day WEDNESDAY, August 9, 2017 to be considered. To be eligible for a grant, the organization is required to be organized under Indiana State laws governing non-profit organizations and having a primary focus benefiting residents living within Wood and Carr Townships. All valid applications received will be reviewed. Unfortunately, due to a limited amount of funds, all applications may not be awarded monies. Awards will be announced Wednesday, August 16, 2017.

About the Wood-Carr Community Fund – The Wood-Carr Community Fund was founded in 1999 and for 17 years has awarded in excess of \$180,000.00 to organizations within Wood and Carr townships. At its core, the Wood-Carr Community Fund is an organization created with gifts from generous people committed to local causes. For donors, the Foundation serves as a philanthropic advisor.
